Many surgical patients need blood transfusions simply because of the type of surgery they are having.

With the above, along with emergencies, the reality is that every two seconds someone in the U.S. needs blood. This is a fact, not an “off the wall guess”, or a statistic that comes from the government or the CDC. This comes from the Red Cross, the nation’s premier organization for obtaining blood donations. They keep very VERY detailed records of where and how donated blood is used.

THE NEED FOR BLOOD DONATIONS DOESN'T STOP BECAUSE IT'S A HOLIDAY. It actually increases. Why? Because quite simply, so many more people are traveling.
